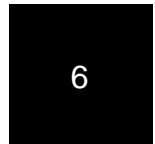

Block#4 "KansasStar" Quilt Block

The fabrics can get confusing because they run from lights to darks & everything in between. So here's the fabrics go into this quilt block & the numbers associated with them:

Lady

GreenRiver

Enchanted
Forest

Money

Black

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) to see if you get the correct block size.

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Block #4 Cutting Requirements for FOUR (4) “Kansas Star” Quilt Blocks

“Kansas Star”
 Quilt Block
 Make a total of FOUR (4)

Money Color#17	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3 1/4" squares
GreenEyedLady Color#14	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 1/2" squares.
GreenRiver Color#15	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3" squares. On the backside of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, ONE (1) time.
GreenRiver Color#15	Cut FOUR (4) 3" squares.
EnchantedForest Color#16	Cut EIGHT (8) 2 1/2" squares.
EnchantedForest Color#16	Cut FOUR (4) 3" squares. On the backside of the squares draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, ONE (1) time.
EnchantedForest Color#16	Cut EIGHT (8) 3" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner to corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.
Black Color#6	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 2 1/2" squares.
Black Color#6	Cut SIXTEEN (16) 3" squares.
Black Color#6	Cut TWENTYFOUR (24) 3" squares. Then cut the squares diagonally, corner to corner, ONE (1) time. You'll end up with TWO (2) triangles per square.

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Block #4 Piecing the "Kansas Star" Quilt Blocks Together

Half Square Triangle (HST) Tutorial

Place the Green River (Color #15) 3" square on the Black (Color #6) 3" square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew (shown in Figure #1). Then cut the Half Square Triangles apart ON the line you drew (shown in Figure #1).

Red line = Drawline

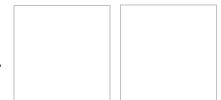
Yellow dashed line = Sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the drawn line

You'll end up with TWO (2) Half Square Triangles (Figure #2). Press toward the darkest fabric. Then trim them down to 2 1/2" square. You need to make a total of THIRTY TWO (32) HST's out of the Green River (Color #15) & Black (Color #6) fabrics.

Repeat this same process for the Green River (Color #15) & the Enchanted Forest (Color #16) HST's. You need to make a total of EIGHT (8) HST's out of these fabric colors.



Quilt Note: When making HST's try cutting your squares 1/4" or 1/2" larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to 2 1/2" square. It ensures that your HST's are never too small for the size you need.

Square in a Square Tutorial

You'll see in my "Cutting Instructions" to cut some squares ONE (1) time, diagonally, corner to corner. There will also be a larger square associated with it. When piecing a portion of a quilt block that calls for a Square in a Square follow the diagram (Figure #1) first.

Then follow the diagram (Figure #2) second.

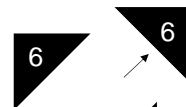

Press in the direction of the arrows.

You need to make a total of SIXTEEN (16) Square in a Square portions for the FOUR (4) "Kansas Star" Quilt Blocks.

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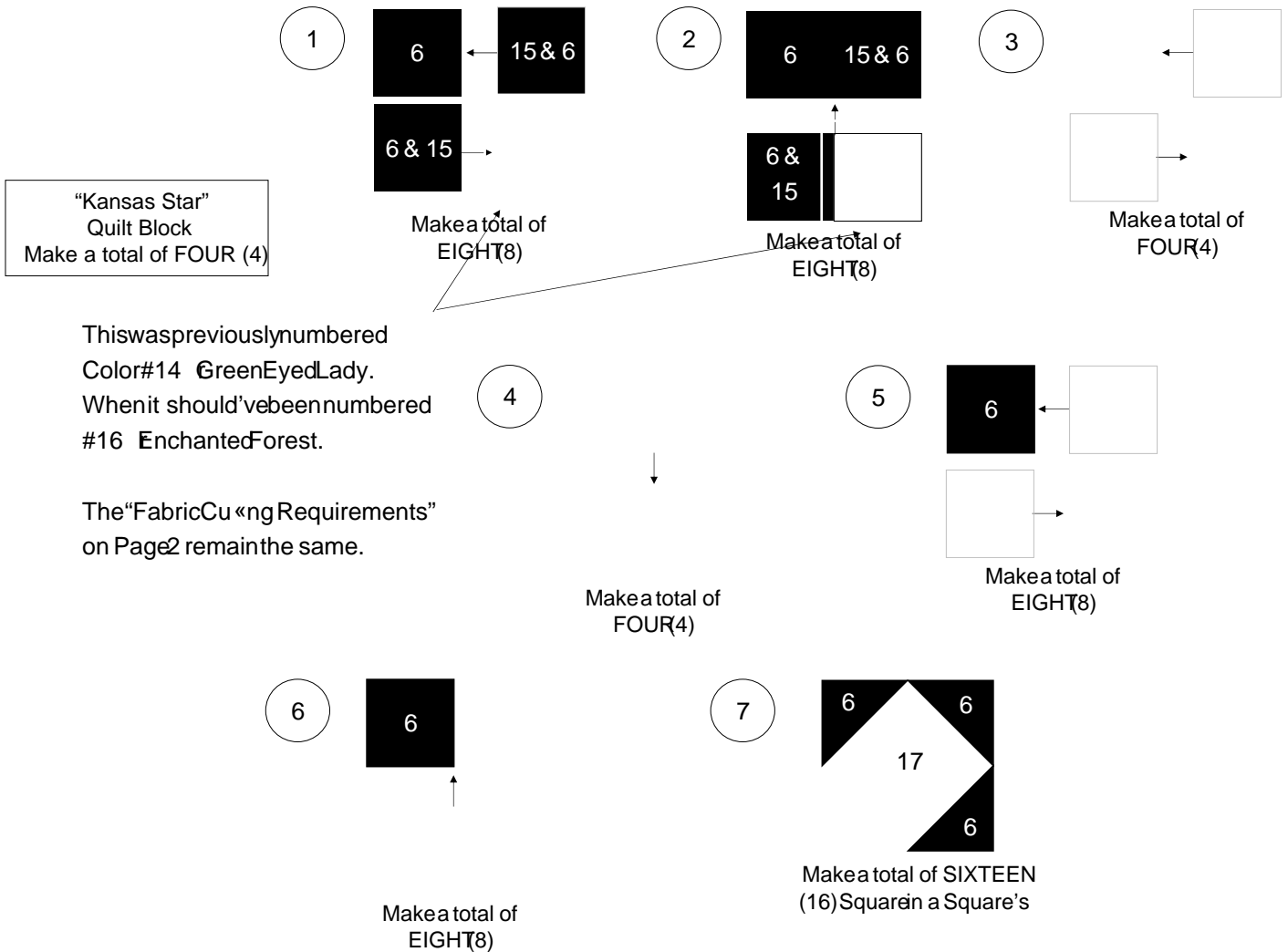
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Block #4 Piecing the "Kansas Star" Quilt Blocks Together (cont.)

As you've sewn the Half Square Triangles & the Flying Geese together, the "Kansas Star" quilt blocks sew together just like a Nine Patch quilt block does!



This was previously numbered Color #14 Green Eyed Lady. When it should've been numbered #16 Enchanted Forest.

The "Fabric Cutting Requirements" on Page 2 remain the same.

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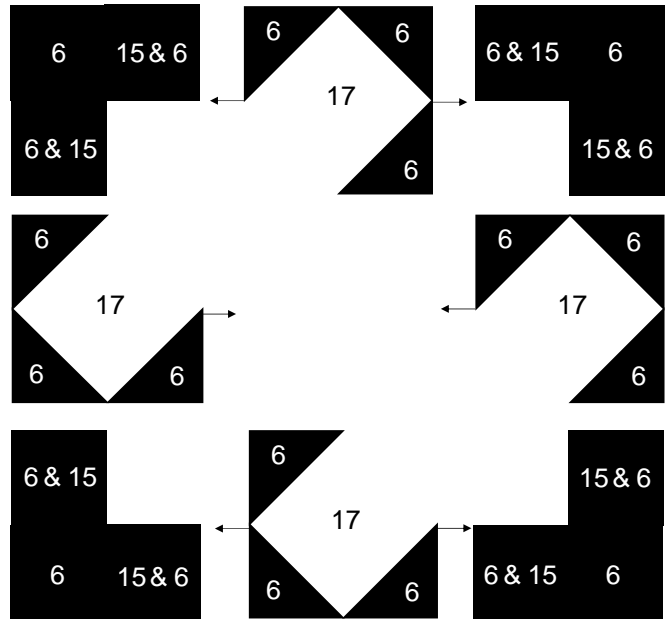

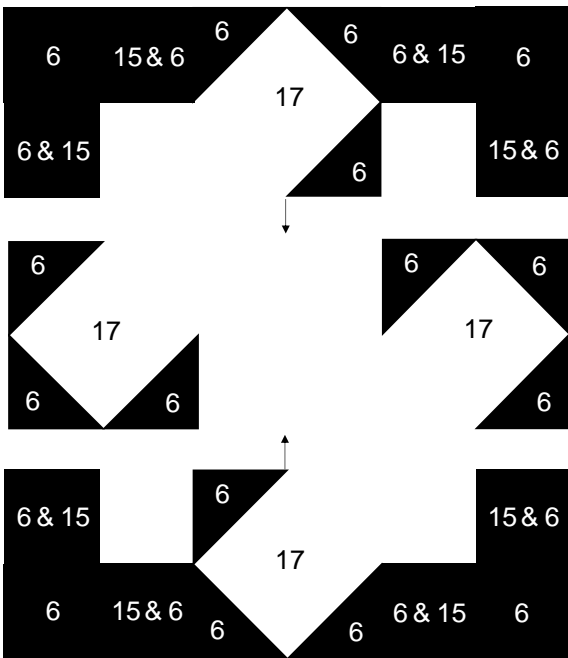
